This is a very simple 2-channel mixer and it sounds great. A great tool to have in your home studio or on your pedal board for parallel effect chains. This is a fairly simple kit to build. Follow the Bill of Materials, the Layout Diagram and General Build Instructions.

You can use any kind of 1uF capacitors, but if you use Tant or Aluminum Electrolytic, pay attention to the polarity. If it's a film 1uF there is no polarity, it doesn't matter.

You will have to do some solder tacking for the input caps and resistors as shown on the diagram.
